Installation, Modification and Care of Rubber Firewall Insulator Panels

Installation: Remove all electrical/mechanical controls from the vehicle metal firewall. Remove mounting fasteners carefully so that they can be cleaned and reused; then remove the old insulator pad. Clean and paint the firewall as required. Position the new Firewall Insulator against the firewall and using a small Phillips screw driver, locate a mounting hole near the top/center of the firewall and insert a long nail. Work toward the sides and bottom inserting nails as you go. When you are satisfied with the fit and alignment, remove a nail and replace with a fastener. You may find the assistance of a friend helpful. Once all of the mounting fasteners are in place, re-install the electrical/mechanical controls, etc. Do not over-tighten mounting screws—"snug them." It is better to tighten them little-by-little-over-time as the materials relax and compress.

Modifications: Many of our Firewall Insulators are shipped with "factory knockouts" inscribed on the surface. Additional holes can be easily installed by cutting through the rubber with an X-Acto type knife and "cross cutting" the insulation material.

Care: This Firewall Insulator is made of a vinyl rubber material and needs little or no care. It can be cleaned like any other upholstery material with a damp cloth or vinyl conditioner. Do not clean with solvents, as this may damage the surface luster.
